

HOME SCHOOL AGREEMENT

In partnership, the school expects parents to:

- ensure children attend school regularly and on time
- ensure children are in the correct school uniform
- take an interest in progress, activities and attend parents' evenings
- support the standards, rewards and consequences in the behaviour policy
- make staff aware of any concerns or problems that affect the child's life at school
- agree to children using the internet in accordance with the school's Online Safety Policy
- to allow my child to go on short escorted walks around the area, in accordance with school policy, e.g visit the park.

In partnership, pupils will be expected to:

- arrive at class and lessons on time
- wear the correct school uniform
- follow teachers' instructions first time
- adhere to behaviour policy of the school and work as hard as possible at all times.

During school trips, in partnership, pupils will be expected to:

- Cooperate fully with staff and all other adults and show respect;
- Take part in the activities;
- Not leave the group or session without permission from an adult;
- Behave sensibly and responsibly at all times;
- Be considerate and polite to others;
- Listen carefully to any rules and follow these at all times and
- Accept that a full written report of any inappropriate behaviour will be forwarded to the Head teacher and to parents or carers.

Photographs	Photographs will be taken to record school based activities. These photos may be shared on several platforms listed below or in school on displays.
Blogging	The classes use the school blog to communicate homework and other school based activities.
Video	The school may record individual or class based activities to share with the wider school via the blog or on Facebook.
Newsletters	School may include pictures of pupils on the school newsletter, to celebrate both individual and class achievements with the wider school community.
Newspapers	From time to time the school may feature in articles within the local press, to celebrate projects and achievements.
Website	The school may use images of pupils to promote learning activities within school.
Tapestry (EYFS pupils)	We use tapestry to share photos and information with parents in nursery and reception, using their own user name and log in.
Google Apps for Education (KS2 Pupils)	Pupils can collaboratively create, edit and share files and websites for school related projects and communicate via email with other pupils / students and members of staff. These services are entirely online and available 24/7 from any Internet-connected computer. Examples of student use include showcasing class projects, building an electronic portfolio of school learning experiences, and working in small groups on presentations to share with others.
