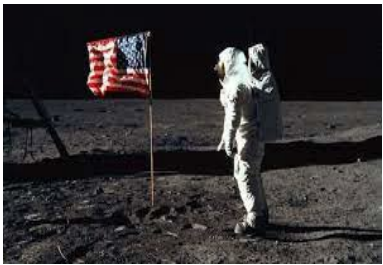


<u>Neil Armstrong (Moon Landing)</u> • This achievement was made possible because of significant changes in scientific understanding and technology. • It happened in 1969. • Buzz Aldrin and Michael Collins were also involved in the landing.	<u>Christopher Columbus</u> • Christopher Columbus was an Italian sailor and explorer who discovered a way to sail from Spain in Europe to the Americas. • Columbus was alive between 1451 and 1506. • Armstrong used spacecraft to travel through the air whilst Columbus would have used a ship to travel through the seas. However, they have both used travel to visit brand new places.	<u>The Titanic</u> • The Titanic set out on her maiden voyage (first big journey), taking people from England to USA – often transporting passengers and cargo. • The Titanic sunk in 1912 • An iceberg loomed out of the darkness. Too big to quickly change direction, Titanic scraped along the side of the ice, tearing holes in at least four sections of the hull.	<u>Arthur Rostron & The Titanic</u> • Arthur Rostron was from Bolton • Carpathia (the ship Rostron captained) rescued 710 passengers from the titanic disaster. He is considered a hero for sailing this ship. • Rostron was asleep in his cabin when news of Titanic reached him. He immediately ordered the ship to change course and raced towards the Titanic’s reported position.	<u>Grace Darling</u> • After seeing survivors clinging on for their life in the sea the two of them (Grace & father) bravely set off in a small rowing boat. They rescued nine survivors from the rocks. • It took place in 1838. • She is significant because many people in Victorian society never imagined that a young woman would be able to do something so courageous. She became a national heroine.	  
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
