

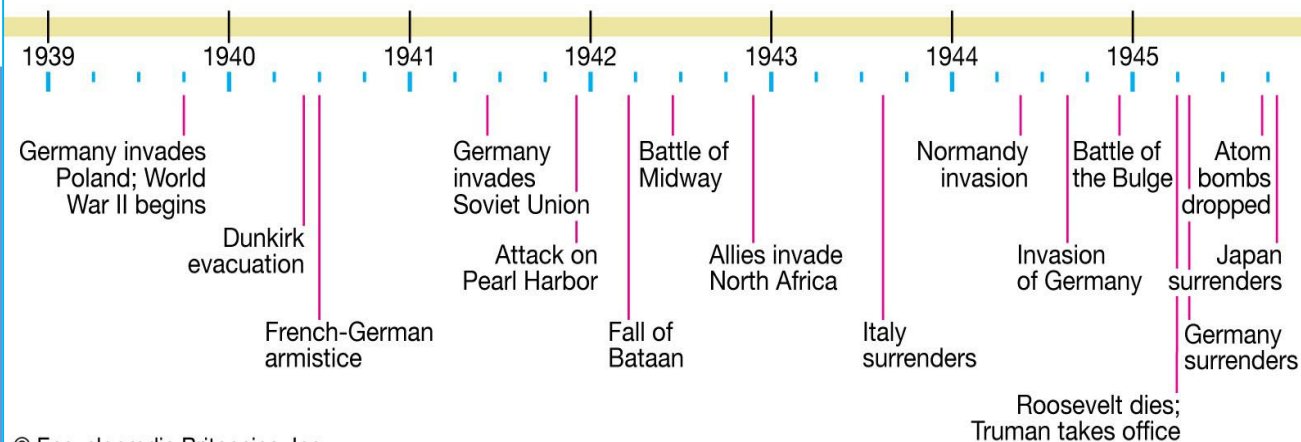

The Battle of Hastings is one of the most important and well known battles in English history. It took place on 14 October 1066 and was the start of the Norman Conquest of England.
